This month we will be getting acquainted with each other again and meet some new classmates. We will explore the fall themes of apples & acorns, farm, scarecrows & cows.

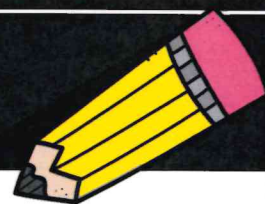
