Dear Parents,

This week as we continue our unit on the "Five Senses", we will focus the sense of sight. We will be walking while blindfolded, and also have fun with a lighted ring toss game. We will also be learning some facts about our eyes. Eyes are one body feature that never grows; they are the same size at birth that they are throughout our lives. We will learn that the black circle in the middle of our eyes is the pupil and that the colored part is the iris. We will be graphing eye color in the room. In addition, we will be making glasses with colored cellophane lenses. Vocabulary consists of: September, sphere, blink, iris, and pupil.

Mr. Wizard will introduce the color blue as we compare different shades of blue from navy to light blue. We will go on a blue walk both in school. The children will identify pictures beginning with Tt and construct T and t with plastic pieces. The children will be printing T and t and will be exploring the objects in the Tt tub. We will also be building words beginning with Tt.

Critter will introduce the triangle shape and the numeral 3. The children will be sequencing numerals 0-1-2-3 and counting objects thru 3. We will be working on peg design and size seriation. The children will be tracing numerals 2 and 3 on wipe off boards. In addition, we will have fun with positions in space and counting to ten.

Work with Phonemic Awareness continues and the children will be building color words yellow, red, blue, with magnetic letters.

Thursday, September 10th - Picture Day- Also each child is to bring in one object beginning with letter Tt.

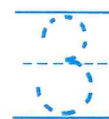
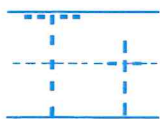
